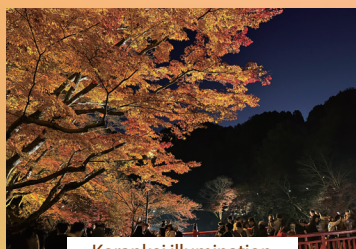

Senmi Shikizakura no Sato

● Subscription Type Organized Tour Contract

This tour is planned and operated by Tourism Toyota (Registered Travel Agency No. 2-1438 approved by the governor of Aichi Prefecture, 1-25, Kozaka-Honmachi, Toyota-shi, Aichi, Japan; hereinafter, "the Company"), and travelers participating in this tour will enter into a subscription type organized tour contract (hereinafter, "tour contract") with the company.

In addition to the following, the tour conditions will also be governed by the tour conditions document (in full) provided separately, the determinate document known as the final itinerary provided prior to departure, and our General Terms and Conditions of Tour Agency Business, the section of the Subscription Type Organized Tour Contract.

● Time of application and conclusion of contract

- (1) The Explanatory Statement of Terms and Conditions shall be delivered as a table (HTML) displayed on the screen.
- (2) A tour contract shall be deemed to be concluded when the reservation/purchase completion screen is displayed after the reservation/purchase information confirmation screen.
- (3) Application fee (per person)

● Payment of tour fees

Payment can be made by credit card only.
You will be asked to complete the payment procedure at the same time as making your reservation online.
Please make a reservation after agreeing to the terms of the contract.
If you are unable to provide your consent, you will not be able to submit an application.

● Cancellation fee

If the traveler cancels the contract for his/her own reason after the tour contract has been concluded, the following cancellation fees will be charged.

Date of contract cancellation	Cancellation fee (per person)
Preceding the start date of the tour	Free
1. Cancellation on the 11th day preceding the tour	Free
2. Cancellation on or after the 10th day (excluding 3-6)	20% of tour fee
3. Cancellation on the 7th day preceding the tour (excluding 4 to 6)	30% of tour fee
4. Cancellation on the day preceding the start date of the tour	40% of tour fee
5. Cancellation on the start date of the tour (excluding 6)	50% of tour fee
6. Cancellation after the start date of the tour or does not participate in the tour without notice	100% of tour fee

● Special compensation

Regardless of whether there is intentional or negligent fault on the part of the Company or the person who made arrangements on behalf of the Company, the Company will pay the following indemnity and a solatium for certain damages caused to the life, body or baggage of the traveler due to a sudden and extraneous accident while participating in the organized tour, in accordance with the separate Rules of Special Compensation attached to the General Terms and Conditions for Subscription Type Organized Tour Contract.

- Compensation for death: JPY 15 million
- Compensation for hospitalization: JPY 20,000 to 200,000
- Hospital visit allowance: JPY 10,000-50,000
- Compensation for damage to personal belongings: Up to JPY 150,000 per passenger (however, limited to JPY 100,000 per covered item)

● Electronic delivery of explanatory documents for terms and conditions of transactions

The items described in the explanatory documents for the terms and conditions of transactions will be delivered by electronic means.

● Accident and other reports

In the event of an accident or other incident during the tour, immediately notify the accompanying tour guide, local staff, transportation, accommodation agency or other travel service provider, or the agency where you applied for the tour. (If there is any circumstances in which notification cannot be made, notify us as soon as circumstances allow.)

● Handling of personal information

The personal information you provide will be used only for the purpose of providing you with information about the relevant travel services, and will not be used for any other purpose.
We will provide your personal information to the business agent to the extent necessary for the procedures for the relevant travel services you have requested.

● Tour terms and standards for tour fee

- (1) These tour conditions are as per May 1, 2026.
 - (2) The prices are also calculated based on the fares and rules in effect as of May 1, 2026.
