Sanshu Asuke Yashiki

Founded in 1980, this is an experiential facilities where you can see and have experiences Japanese traditional life.



Kojakuji-temple



The maple trees of Korankei originated in 1634 when the resident priest of this temple planted baby trees of maple one by one while chanting Buddhist sutra. After that, local people planted trees through generations.

Koranbashi (Suspension-bridge)



The morning sun is successful well around here. You can see the beautiful colored leaves which are reflected in the surface of the river.

Tsumagoi Yakushi

When you go up the stairs from Ochibe parking lot, there is a small hall of heating Buddha. People believe that the love will fulfill when they play. Nearby, there is a big ginkgo tree which has many breast-shaped lumps. So, it is said that mother's milk sells well when they wish.

Asukejo-castle



This castle is a mountain castle of the warring states period. There is no other castle in Japan that was built completely based on the excavations. You can see a view of the entire Asuke town from here.
